



HOLY WEEK BEGINS APRIL 2



Palm Sunday – All the events of God's plan of salvation for us begin with Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The disciples and the crowd shout "Hosanna, blessed is He who comes I the name of the Lord. Hosanna to the Son of David."

We gather in the narthex and Great Hall to begin our worship with the Blessing and Procession of Palms.

TRIDUUM – The Great Three Days – Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

On Maundy Thursday, Jesus gathered his disciples in the Upper Room to celebrate the Passover. He gives his disciples a "going away" commandment that "you love one another as I have loved you." After instituting for us the Sacrament of his own body and blood, Jesus is betrayed.

On Maundy Thursday, we gather at 12:00 and 7:00 in the sanctuary (with lunch to follow the noon service). We celebrate Holy Communion and at 7:00 conclude the service with the stripping of the altar, symbolizing Jesus' treatment by Pilate and the Roman soldiers. The 7:00 service will be streamed.

Good Friday marks Jesus' trial and crucifixion. Death seems to hold sway that day. Jesus is buried in haste, before the beginning of the Sabbath (Friday sundown).

On Good Friday, we gather at 12:00 and 7:00. At noon, we gather on Front Street, outside the Presbyterian Church (weather permitting) for the traditional Way of the Cross. Pastor Mittermaier shares one of the meditations. At 7:00, we gather in our sanctuary to grieve our Savior's death.

There are no services on Holy Saturday (though some congregations celebrate a Vigil of Easter late in they day. That day was the sabbath day – the day God rested from the creative work described in Genesis.

EASTER – THE QUEEN OF FEASTS – APRIL 9

The morning begins with a Community Sunrise Service at 7:00 at Marcum Park. Patti Eaton represents Zion by doing a reading. We have a breakfast "feast" beginning and 8:30 here at Zion and at 10:00 we celebrate the Resurrection our Lord. God is at work doing a new thing – raising Jesus from the dead – and giving us new and eternal life. A new Sabbath is created, celebrating the events of that first day of the week!

> "He lives! And because He lives, we too shall live!" Alleluia!




